What assistance is available?

Support to divert waste away from landfill through a variety of take-back services, building material re-use centres and end market development for waste materials.

Package 3 - Training

Training sessions and tool box talks explaining how SWMPs can be implemented, plus groundwork and pre-demolition best practice advice.
